Have you ever thought about starting a Hispanic ministry?

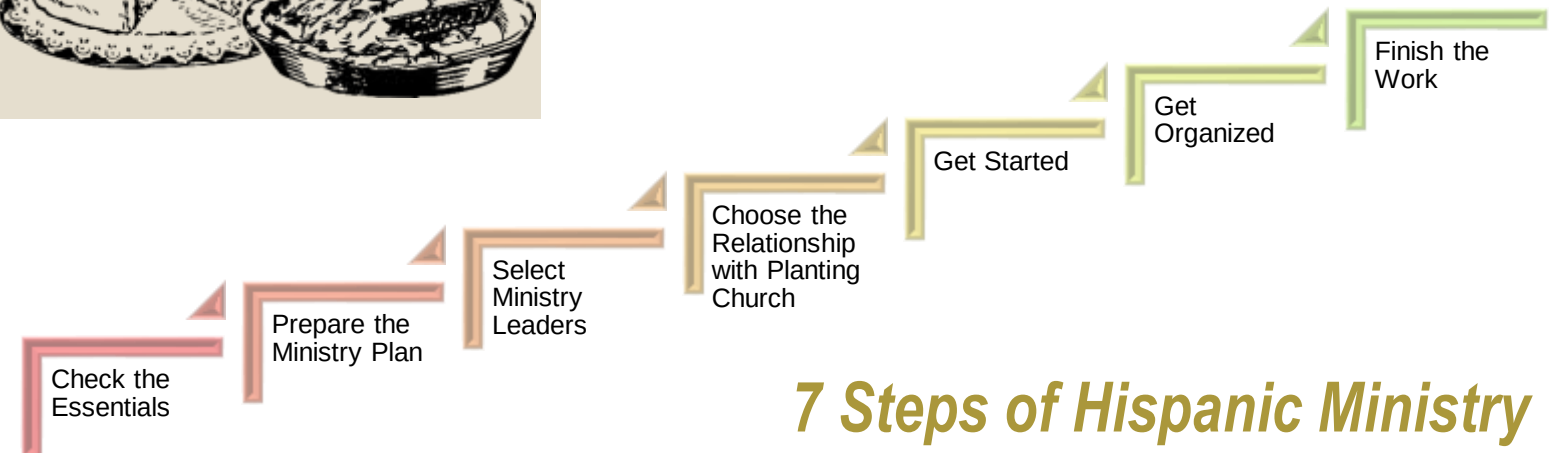
CrossLink provides free consulting services for churches that walks them through every step of launching, organizing, and planning the future of a Hispanic ministry or church plant.

Facilities. Last year, we began to make improvements to the church building. Thanks to God and the generosity, support, and work of many – our building has a renewed view and is ready to welcome anyone.

This has allowed us to do a better job in this area and to improve the broadcasts of our live bilingual Sunday service – which has between 400-600 weekly views online. Life Groups. In collaboration with a local church, we started a new Life Group in Spanish in our home. The intention is to bridge families from two churches and learn from the Word. We pray that the Lord will soon make this group grow and allow us to open new home Bible studies.
